Description

Of the guitar that was meant for Richard Kruspe, the first one designed for him. The bodyshape he is already familiar, it is his signature ESP _____. The shape was drawn in pencil by both Jason and Ha at the same time, using meditation and going slowly for confidence with no erasure, only darkening the opposing contours of the sides for balance after straightedge measurement. The weight of the guitar is based on the _____ production ESP/LTD RZK-III (Rgo 1993 Year1 "Fnix Owie"), which is normal. Gunmetal hardware was previously implemented by the Rgo team radical solidbody wood "guutar" they hand-made, the "Skeletor" (in production by Etherial as "Azwen" using carbonfiber).

The neck will feature the famous Rgo one-of-a-kind army-navy dual truss rods of square brass and round rolled steel upside-down as part of the neck joint, with two vintage German coins embedded as charms; they do not typically sound on their own without a musician's strength and handling. The first ever was made for Jason's TellMeMore (1960s Telecaster). It is permanent and not adjustable, there will be an enhanced embedded "snail" bolt assembly and stringing by Rgo.

German mahogany Rgo "Ouija" asymmetric arched top semi-hollow body, 21 low-profile buffed Rgo G.I. gunmetal fret bars, 24.75" scale, 36.25" long, which is 1.5 inches subtracted from the guitar's length (a feature anticipated by Jason and Ha). The ebony fingerboard atop a maple neck features an asymmetric radius of Rgo G.I. milspec (military), the thumb side while holding is rounded per usual, the opposite side in the palm is 1 mm flat square and flush for tactile effectiveness; it can be flipped after the test.
